Free visa

Most ASEAN nations can get a visa exemption valid for 14 days Singapore Passport: Visa free for 30 days

Tourists from Japan, South Korea, Macao and Hong Kong with ordinary passports are allowed to stay in Myanmar for 30 days.



Electronic Visa (e-Visa)

Citizens of 100 countries can apply online for tourist visas through the government website. An e-visa is valid for 28 days.






Day 02 | Yangon city tour

Bogyoke Market or Scott Market /Sule Pagoda /Explore Yangon 's famous **colonial buildings and churches.** or visit **The Bogyoke Aung San Museum**, **the National Museum and the Myanmar Gems Museum** will give you great insight into the history of this great nation .













Drive or take a picturesque ferry ride on the Yangon river to visit *Twante*, a quaint village by the riverside. The journey will give you a glimpse of Myanmar countryside as you pass through rice fields, villages with bamboo huts and banana plantations.

Twante is also famous for ceramic and pottery work. You can visit the workshops and pick up mementoes.



Or spend a day in **Bago** (**Pagoda** visit)




Mawlamyine, formerly Moulmein, is the 4th largest city of Myanmar, 300 km south east of Yangon and 70 km south of Thaton, at the mouth of Thanlwin River. The city is the capital and largest city of Mon State and the main trading center and seaport in south eastern Myanmar.

***There are only 2 local 4 star hotel in this city, many others are 3 stars hotel. During peak season, rooms are always fully booked.

If you wish to travel to this city, need to plan very advance.

Due to the long travelling time (one way 5 hr.) Suggest to stay min 1 night in this city.





Please take note:

Mawlamyine relatively close to the Thai border it has had associations with drug trafficking, so be cautious not to get involved in anything to do with drugs or the drug trade during your time there as penalties are harsh it goes without saying that people in this industry aren't likely to be trustworthy.

Bagan, located on the banks of the Ayeyarwady (Irrawaddy) River, is home to the largest and densest concentration of Buddhist temples, pagodas, stupas and ruins in the world with many dating from the 11th and 12th centuries. The temple town of Myanmar has more than 2,000 temples. A UNESCO's World Heritage Site, which is Myanmar's second entry on the World Heritage List.


About Inle Lake

Inle Lake is the second largest lake in Myanmar and is located at the heart of the country.

The lake is surrounded by mountains on all sides offering a breathtaking natural view. The area is rich in animals and plant species and you can see some of the rarest species here.

The lake is home to several ethnic tribes of Myanmar who follow well-preserved traditions and cultures.

A visit will provide you with an opportunity to interact with locals and learn some of their traditional ways of planting, fishing, cooking and making handicrafts.

Visit *Shwezigon pagoda*, one of the most revered temples in Bagan built by King Anawrahta. Continue to *Htilominlo Temple*, one of the five oldest temples in Bagan built by red brick noted for its majestic 46 meters tall. Then, visit the *Ananda Temple*, an architectural masterpiece of Bagan built in the 11th century.



Day 05 | Bagan Hot Air Ballooning tour

In the afternoon, Cruise down the Irrawaddy River to Shwezigon Pagoda. A private Myanmar boat tour on the river to enjoy beautiful sunset.


