# About Cambodia



## Where is Cambodia?

Officially the Kingdom of Cambodia, on the Indochinese mainland of Southeast Asia. Cambodia is largely a land of plains and great rivers and lies amid important overland and river trade routes linking China to India and Southeast Asia.

International borders are shared with Thailand and the Lao People’s Democratic Republic on the West and the North, and the Social Republic of Viet Nam on the East and the Southeast. The country is bounded on the Southeast by the Gulf of Thailand.

**Religion:** Theravada Buddhism (97%), Islam, Christianity, Animism

**Siem Reap** is Cambodia’s principal tourist town.

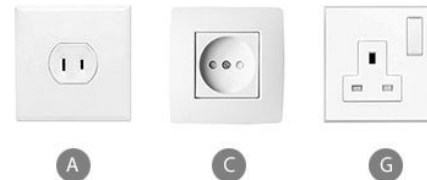

### Cambodia Visa Policy



#### **Free visa**

The nationals of the Laos, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, Brunei Darussalam, Myanmar **Do not need a tourist visa** and may stay in Cambodia for 21 and 30 days respectively.

### VISA on Arrival

**Most visitors** can apply visa are obtainable upon arrival at both Phnom Penh and Siem Reap International Airports in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap. At land crossing from Thailand, Vietnam and Laos, visa can be obtained at International Check Point border.

- Cool season: November- March (22-28c)

- Hot season: March- May (28c -38c)

Monsoons season: May - October (24-32c, with humidity up to 90%.)

## *MUST visited places*



### **Visit Siem Reap & Angkor Archeological Park - Angkor Wat**

Siem Reap province is located in northwest Cambodia. It is the major tourist hub in Cambodia, as it is the closest city to the world famous temples of Angkor (the Angkor temple complex is north of the city).

#### **Angkor Archeological Park - Angkor Wat**

UNESCO World heritage site in 1992.

Stretching over some 400 square kilometres, including forested area, Angkor Archeological Park contains the magnificent remains of several capitals of the Khmer Empire of the 9th to the 15th centuries, including the largest pre-industrial city in the world. The most famous are the Temple of Angkor Wat and, at Angkor Thom, the Bayon Temple with its countless sculptural decorations .



### **Phnom Penh - French Built City**

#### **The Royal Palace in Phnom Penh**

The Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda in Phnom Penh are the city's finest example of twentieth-century Khmer influenced architecture. The Royal Palace is set back from the riverbank on Sothearos Boulevard. You can stroll this complex of regal structures and perfectly manicured grounds. While there, you will gain an insight into Cambodia's past and present. A blue flag flies when the King is in residence. While the palace itself is off-limits, it's possible to visit several buildings within the grounds. The Silver Pagoda is named for its floor which is covered in gleaming silver.

### **Floating Villages on Tonle Sap**

**Tonle Sap Lake; the largest freshwater lake in South East Asia and is also an ecological hot spot that was designated as a [UNESCO biosphere in 1997](#).**

Tonle Sap lake is home to dozens of picturesque floating villages. Explore the fascinating houses built from bamboo and raised on stilts; they are mainly inhabited by Vietnamese fisherman. You'll pass floating markets, schools and pagodas and learn more about local life.

**Cheug Ek - the killing field** that proceeded more than 20 thousands of civilians and the site is connecting with **Tuol Sleng Museum** - was the former school that was transformed to Tortured Prison S21.

Stroll around **Russian Market** for shopping.

Evening, we head to Phnom Penh's Riverside then get on board with a welcome cocktail from drink menu while the boat is slowly cruising along Mekong & Tonle Sap, watch the sunset fading at horizon before buffet dinner is started to serve, unwind yourself with colorful Phnom Penh nightlights. Disembark and return hotel.

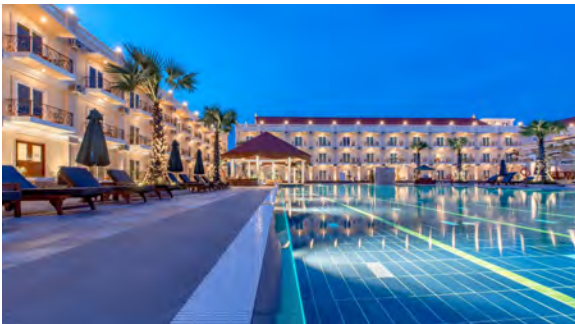

### About Battambang

Battambang is Cambodia's second-largest city and the capital of Battambang Province, which was founded in the 11th century. It is the former capital of Monton Kmer and lies in the heart of the Northwest of Cambodia.

It is located in one of the biggest rice-growing areas in Southeast Asia. The province is bordering to the North with Banteay Meanchey, to the West with Thailand, to the East and South with Pursat and the great lake Tonle Sap.

It's a riverside town, home to some of the best-preserved, French colonial architecture in the country.

### How to get to Battambang ?

From **Siem Reap** to Battambang -**By bus** takes around 3 hours.

From **Phnom Penh** to Battambang -By bus takes around 6 hours.



### Climate

During the rainy season between mid-April and mid-October the Mekong swells and backs into the Tonle Sap (Great Lake), increasing the size of the lake almost threefold.

General information about the climate:

- Rainy season: June - October (<31c)
- Cool season: November- February (>26c)
- Hot season: March- May : Temperature: from 28c -35c

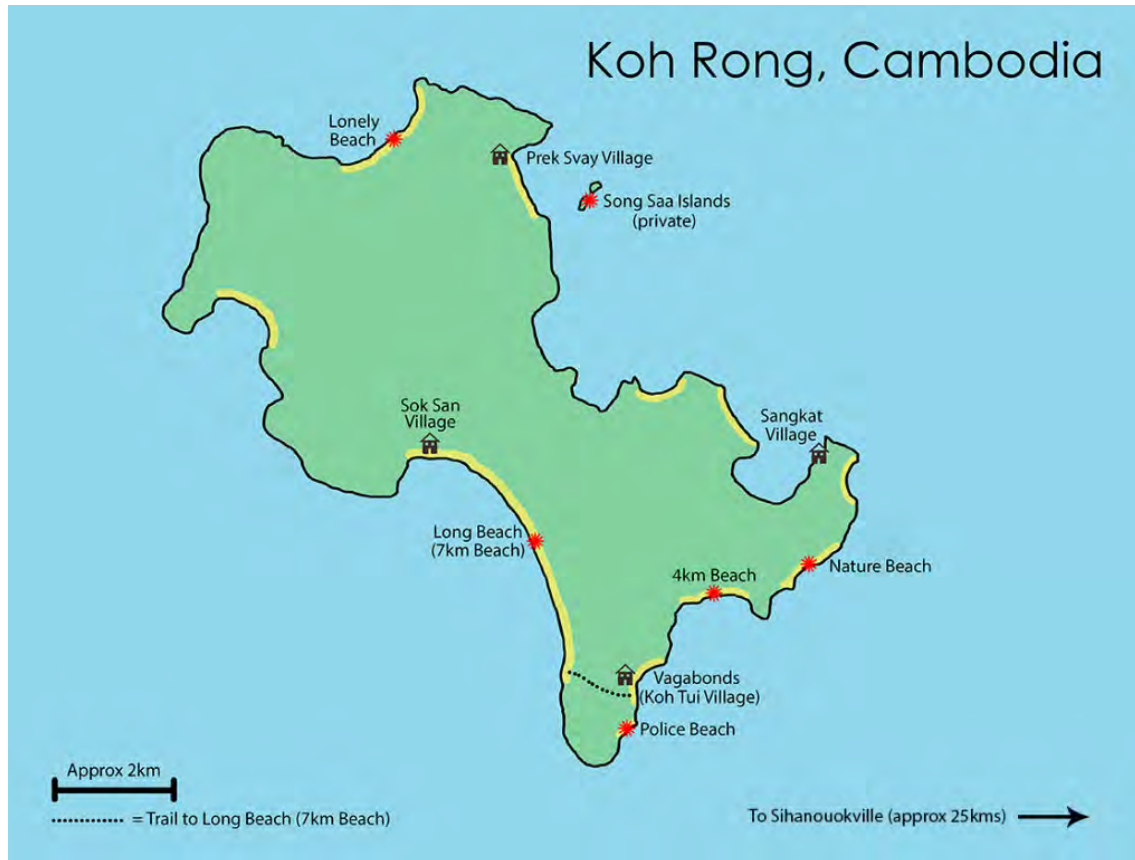


### About Koh Rong Island

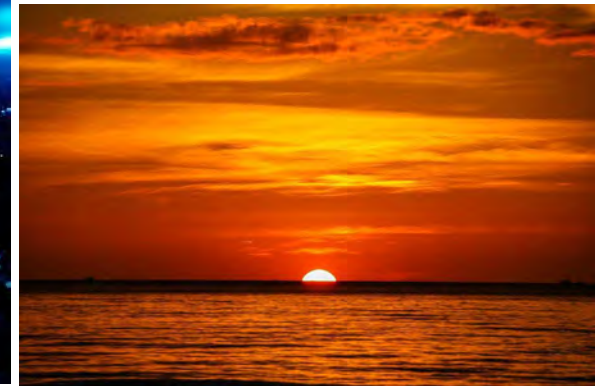

The best time to visit Kampot is after the monsoon (September-October), when the rice fields are green, temperatures are cool, and it's less crowded.

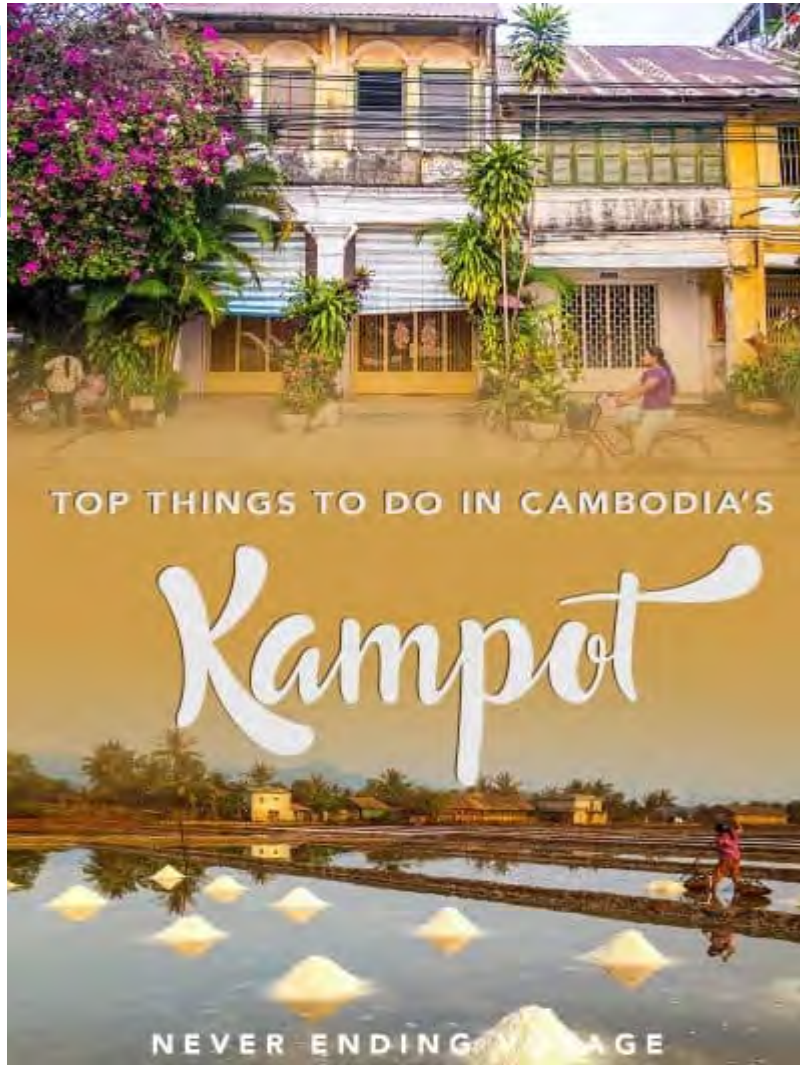
### **How to get to *Kampot*?**

## About Mekong River

The Mekong River is one of the world's great rivers. Originating in Tibet, not far from the source of the Yangtze River, it tumbles down through the Himalayas and southern *China* into Southeast Asia and flows along the borders of *Laos, Burma and Thailand* through the heart of the *Golden Triangle into Cambodia*, where it flows in one direction in the wet season and the opposite direction in the dry season. It finally empties into the South China Sea at the Mekong Delta in Vietnam. Its source in Tibet as not discovered until 1994.

The Mekong River goes by many names. It is known as *Lancang Jiang* (Turbulent River) in China, the Mae Nam Khing in Thailand, Myanmar and Laos, Tonle Than (Great Waters) in Cambodia and Cuu Long (Nine Dragons) in Vietnam. It is also known as River of Stone, Dragon Running River, Mother River Khong, and Big Water.

The Mekong is the *longest river in Southeast Asia*, the 12th longest in the world and the 10th largest in terms of volume.

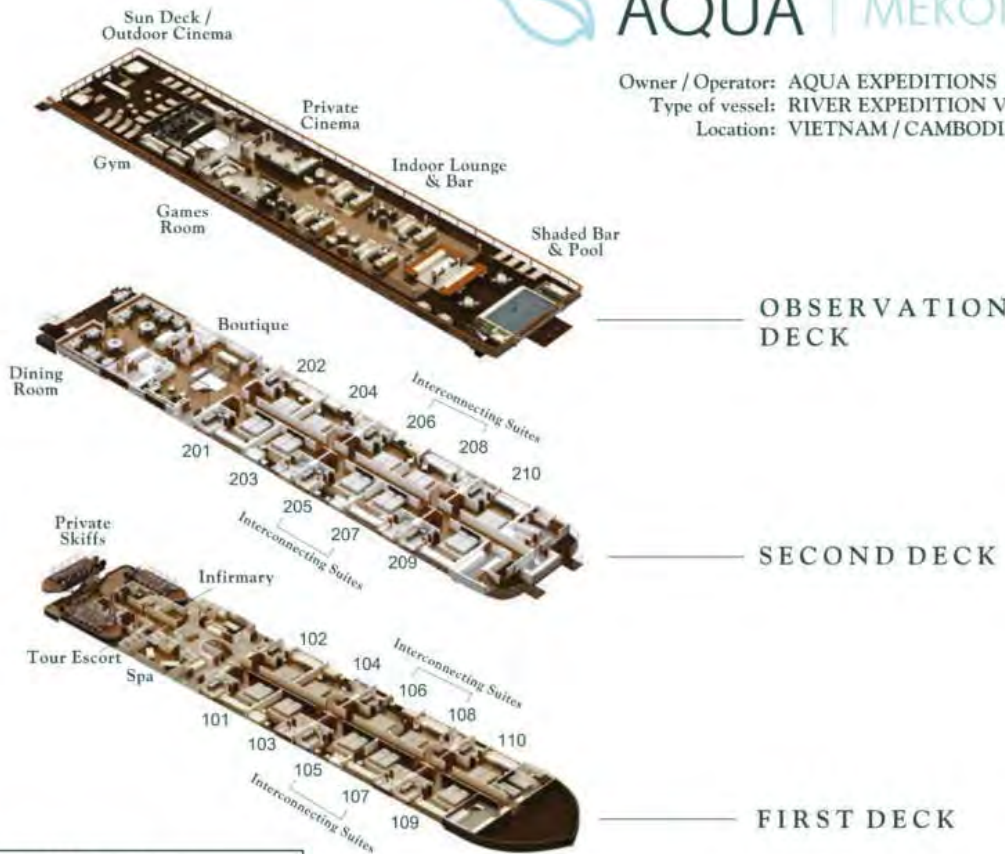
